The following material is set forth so that the Bible believer might see *for himself* just how the modern versions of the Bible affect Bible doctrine. This is a very important subject to the student of the Word of God. It may be that many are unaware of this critical problem. Some may even have thought it to be unimportant, having been led to believe that the differences between the King James Version and the modern translations are minor. This is simply not the case.

I Thessalonians 5:21 tells us to:

*“Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.”*

As the old saying goes, “the proof of the pudding is in the eating.” As Bible believers, we should analyze the versions and see which one will stand the test! And *what* can be the standard – but the doctrine itself? We will test the Bible by its own words!

After having put the versions to the test we can then identify the “good” and hold to it “fast.” In Philippians 1:10 Paul says:

*“That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ.”*

After having “proved all things,” we are then equipped to “approve things that are excellent.” This will lead

to us being “sincere and without offence till the day of Christ.” This is the idea of II Timothy 2:15,

*“Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”*

*"Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience."*

LIVING BIBLE

They must be earnest, wholehearted followers of Christ who is the hidden Source of their faith.

NEW INTERNATIONAL VERSION

They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience.

GOOD NEWS FOR MODERN MAN

They should hold the revealed truth of the faith with a clear conscience.

**IN ME FIRST**

KING JAMES

*"Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting."*

*"But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as the gospel of the circumcision was unto Peter;"*

LIVING BIBLE

# *Divine Forgiveness*

Colossians 1:14

## **I. THE DEFINITION OF FORGIVENESS**

- A. “The act of forgiving; the pardon of an offender, by which he is considered and treated as not guilty.

“The pardon or remission of an offense or crime” (Webster).

- B. “Dismission, discharge, setting free ... The forgiveness of sins on the part of God, and with reference to future Judgement; total remission and forgiveness excluding all idea of punishment” (Bullinger).

- C. The word for forgiveness (aphesis – Strong’s #859 meaning freedom or pardon) is also the word translated remission.

## **II. THE TIMING OF DIVINE FORGIVENESS**

- A. Present tense possession – Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14.
- B. Based upon a past tense accomplishment – Colossians 2:13.

## **III. THE BASIS OF DIVINE FORGIVENESS**

- A. Christ is the basis of forgiveness – Ephesians 4:32; Acts 13:38.
- B. Forgiveness is the product and process of redemption – Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14.
- C. Forgiveness is trans-dispensationally based upon blood – Hebrews 9:22; Matthew 26:28; Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14.

- D. Christ’s Righteousness – Romans 3:25.

## **IV. THE DISPENSATIONAL ASPECT OF FORGIVENESS**

- A. In “time past” forgiveness was directed toward Israel – Matthew 26:28; Luke 1:77; Acts 5:31.
- B. In “time past” forgiveness was directly associated with water baptism – Mark 1:4 (c.f. Romans 3:25); Luke 3:3; Acts 2:38.
- C. In “but now” forgiveness is directed toward “ALL who believe” (Rom. 3:22, 26), and based solely and unconditionally on the merit of God’s grace – the “free gift” (Rom. 5:15; Eph. 2:8, 9)

## **V. THE MEASURE OF DIVINE FORGIVENESS**

- A. According to the riches of His grace – Ephesians 1:7.
- B. The identity of the measure – Romans 5:20 (His grace “did much more abound”).

## **VI. THE NATURE OF DIVINE FORGIVENESS**

- A. It is Perfect forgiveness – “ALL” sins (past, present and future) – Colossians 2:13.
- B. It is Eternal forgiveness – once our sins are forgiven they will never be brought up again – Romans 8:33, 34.
- C. It is Authentic forgiveness – many say “Yes, I forgive, BUT...” The Lord has no BUTS in His forgiveness – Psalm 103:12.





# Prerequisites to Body Life

Ephesians 4:15-16; Colossians 2:19

## I. A PROPER RELATIONSHIP WITH THE WORD OF GOD

*“But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into Him in all things ...”* (Ephesians 4:15a).

For Spiritual Growth:

### A. There MUST BE TRUTH

Truth is the nutrition of spiritual growth.

- ❖ The SOURCE of Truth (John 17:17)
- ❖ The DIVISION of Truth (II Timothy 2:15; II Peter 1:12)
- ❖ The ABSENCE of Truth (II Timothy 4:3, 4; I Timothy 6:5a)

We cannot get past this issue! The Word of God is the source of all spiritual life, including body life (John 6:63; Hebrews 4:12)! The Body cannot progress in spiritual growth without a steady supply of God’s Word (c.f. I Peter 2:2).

### B. The TRUTH MUST BE SPOKEN

Body life must spring from faithful communication of Bible doctrine, reproof, correction and instruction in righteousness (II Timothy 3:16, 17).

#### 1. The PROCESS – II Timothy 3:16

##### ❖ DOCTRINE:

Strong’s #1319: “instruction” – This word is also translated as “learning” and “teaching.”

##### ❖ REPROOF:

Strong’s #1650: “proof, conviction” –

This word is also translated as “evidence” and “tell” (take special note of “tell” in Matthew 18:15).

The idea here is to “bring an issue home.”

##### ❖ CORRECTION:

Strong’s #1882: “straightening up again.”

##### ❖ INSTRUCTION:

Strong’s #3809: “tutorage or training; by implication disciplinary correction” – This word is also translated as “chastening,” “chastisement” and “nurture.”

##### ❖ A word that describes this process: ADMONISH

Strong’s #3560: “to put in mind, i.e. (by implication) to caution or reprove gently.

Strong’s #3559: “calling attention to, i.e., (by implication) mild rebuke or warning” (See Colossians 3:16).

#### 2. The RESULT – II Timothy 3:17

- a. Adulthood – “man of God”
- b. Fully equipped – “thoroughly furnished”

### C. The TRUTH MUST BE SPOKEN IN LOVE

There must be the communication of doctrine in an atmosphere of divine love. The truth spoken in envy, strife, contention and pretense has little effect. It has no eternal value (I Corinthians 13:2-3).

## II. A PROPER RELATIONSHIP WITH THE HEAD

“... may grow up into Him in all things, which is the Head, even Christ: from Whom ...” (Ephesians 4:15b, 16a).

“And not holding the Head, from which ...” (Colossians 2:19).

### A. Recognizing the Head

The Lord Jesus Christ is the Head of the Body (Colossians 1:18). In fact it is HIS BODY! He is the living Head and it is He who gives life to the members.

NO ONE ELSE has the right to hold this position! The life of the Body of Christ is dependent upon holding the Head in His proper relationship and function to the rest of the Body. This is essential.

### B. The Meaning of HEADSHIP

What is the issue in HEADSHIP? What is the issue involved? *Authority* (Ephesians 5:23). And what is our ONLY proper response to authority? *Submission*.

The break down of the life and function of the Body of Christ begins with a failure to hold the Head in His preeminent place!

### C. The Rejection of Headship

1. Not Functional At All – dead (I Timothy 5:6)

When a part of the body is non-responsive to the authority of Christ in their life they can become paralyzed (or “dead,” not functioning).

2. Functioning wildly – enemies (Philippians 3:18)

Or they can become wild and uncontrolled (palsy) and in actual opposition to the head.

## III. A PROPER RELATIONSHIP WITH OTHER BODY MEMBERS

### A. Body Members are FITTED Together

“... the whole Body fitly joined together and compacted” (Ephesians 4:16)

#### 1. The Words

##### ❖ FITLY JOINED TOGETHER

Strong’s #4883: “to render close-jointed together”

##### ❖ COMPACTED

Strong’s #4822: “to drive together”

What comes to mind as we think of the word “compact?”

The idea here is one of eliminating the “space” between members of the Body; removing the emptiness that exists between them.

The Body members are then “close” (spaceless) and can be said to be, using the modern vernacular, “tight.”

The issue of “individualism” and “self” is then replaced by one of unity, oneness, fellowship, *cooperation* and **communion**. Some saints, echoing the philosophy of the world, say, “I need my space,” when in fact God is working to eliminate the space.

#### 2. The Applications

##### a. Requires TIME & EFFORT

This, for all practical purposes, requires much time and effort. This is not an easy process. We do not “naturally” fit together.

##### b. There is MUCH that hinders a close FIT

We have much on the exterior that hinders a good “fit.” We all, humanly speaking, come from as many varying backgrounds and have as many unique characteristics as there are parts of us. And these must be fitted together by God.

c. NOT Limited to Position

This fitting is not just limited to position, we must have this done in our day-to-day life. We must have our “rough” edges knocked off.

d. The Fitting Process

Therefore, before full Body life can be enjoyed, there must be much “cutting,” “planing,” “rasping,” and “sandpapering” done to each of us.

e. Are We Co-operating?

Are we resisting such an effort because it is too difficult? Or are we “submitting one to another in the fear of God” so that this process can find its completion in us?

B. Body Members are HELD together

“every joint” (Ephesians 4:16)  
“joints and bands” (Colossians 2:19)

1. The Word

❖ JOINT & BANDS

Strong’s #860: “ligament”

2. The Application

The “joints” are the “fasteners” of the Body members. No relationships, no Body life!

“A joint is not a member, it is the interface or ‘place of relationship’ between two members. A healthy body functions,

not simply because members are strong, but because their strengths are properly related and coupled together (Ephesians 4:15, 16; Colossians 2:19). Our spiritual growth depends upon the quality of our inter-relationships with brothers and sisters as well as upon our personal relationship with the Lord.” Dale Rumble, *The Diakonate* (p. 11).

Once the Body members have been “fitted” together, in a practical sense, then “joints” (ligaments) hold the parts together. Relationships are the “joints” and they are developed to a “holding” quality through TRUST and COMMITMENT

C. Body Members are SUPPLIED Together

2. The Application

a. The Full Supply of Growth is Now Possible

As the Body members are “fitted” together and “held” there by the “joints,” then the Body has opportunity to enjoy the supply that God has designed to come from the Body. Each Body member plays a crucial role.

b. The Result: The BODY is EDIFIED

The result is edification and spiritual growth. But mind you, it is corporate! – “the edifying of *ITSELF* in love!” *ITSELF!* Not ourselves, not me, not you – but the Body ***ITSELF!***

c. The importance of **MUTUAL MINISTRY AND GROWTH**

We have a tendency, in our lives, to get caught up with self and individualism. We must remember that we now have been brought into living **UNION** with Christ and each other – our life is a Body life! God is not so much concerned with individual growth and ministry as He is with the growth and ministry of the Body. God has not designed it so that we as *individual* believers grow independently and do our own ministry thing. God is not looking for a man, nor a few good men, rather He is looking for His Body!

d. God’s Way – or NO Way

“... increaseth with the increase of God” (Colossians 2:19).

The Body is to grow in the growth of God. We are to grow in His designed way!

Truly none of us can say, “I have no need of thee.” ■
