“The First Resurrection” (i.e., “the Former Resurrection”)

*But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is **the first resurrection**. Blessed and holy is he that hath part in **the first resurrection**: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years (Revelation 20:5-6, KJV).*

*(The rest of the dead do not live until the thousand years should be finished.) This is **the former resurrection**. Happy and holy is he who is having part in **the former resurrection**! Over these the second death has no jurisdiction, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will be reigning with Him the thousand years (CV).*



“The First Resurrection,” specifically mentioned by name, is found only in Revelation 20. This is a *prophetic* resurrection that takes place *before* the Thousand-Year reign of Christ on Earth. It is “first” only in the sense that it precedes the resurrection that takes place *after* His Millennial Kingdom.

The “first resurrection” is the former of the two resurrections referred to in this passage. It is the antithesis of the resurrection implied though not specifically mentioned in Revelation 20:12. This is the resurrection which was both the subject of revelation and the hope of Israel ...

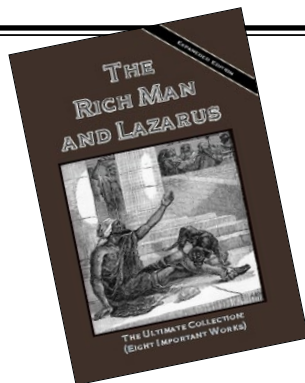
This is the resurrection concerning which Paul wrote

during the Acts Period, “they that are Christ’s at His **Parousia**.”¹

1. *Parousia* (παρουσία, G3952, SEC) at its base means “personal presence,” and is used for the *official* presence of Christ on Earth as manifest during the Millennial Kingdom. The *Parousia* is initiated by Christ’s Second Advent. Thus, it is translated: “coming” (KJV), “arrival” (Moffatt; Analytical-Literal), and “presence” (Concordant; Diaglott; Rotherham; Young). The *Parousia* is central to the Messianic prophecies and Israel’s ultimate hope. However, the *Parousia* is **not** the hope of the One Body, and therefore the word “*parousia*” is not found in Ephesians or Colossians, the epistles of the Secret Administration. Our hope is our joint-appearing with Christ in Glory, “far above all Heavens” (i.e., among the Celestials in the Super-Heavens – Colossians 3:1-4; cf., Ephesians 4:10).

When we think of the Lord Jesus Christ returning to this Earth, we think of it as Him *Coming* to take His place as King. The normal word (Greek, *erchomai*) just means “to come,” but the special word for “personal coming” (Greek, *parousia*) is said to be “a being alongside” or “a presence” (Young’s *Analytical Concordance*, page 188). This word *parousia* really is a personal presence, an appearance in an *official* capacity because of who He is and what He can do. — Otis Q. Sellers (1901-1992), *Glossary of Words*.

The Greek word rendered “Coming” (*Parousia*) does not mean simply “coming.” ... Many have recognized that *parousia* does

The Pre-Millennial Kingdom is the Divine process which consummates in the *Parousia* of Christ on Earth for 1000 years. ... The consummation of “the Day of Christ” will be when He returns to Earth with great fanfare and mighty power (I Thessalonians 4:16-17), to have rule and dominion over the Heavens and Earth in His *Parousia* for a thousand years. – Tom L. But you are a chosen generation, a **Royal PRIESTHOOD**, a **Holy Nation**, a peculiar people (I Peter 2:9).

Like Paul during the Book of Acts, those who take part in this prophetic “first resurrection,” will be

... acting as a **PRIEST** of the evangel of God, that the approach present of the nations may be becoming well received ... (Romans 15:16).

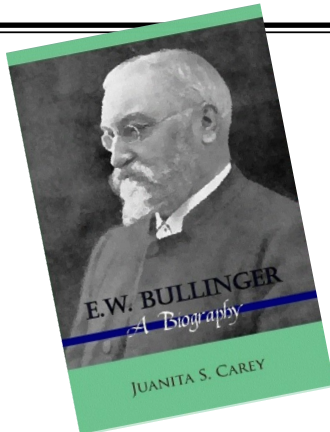
Thus, E.W. Bullinger (1837-1913) wrote concerning this “*Kingdom of Priests*,” noting that it referred to,

The whole nation being a priest with respect to other nations, as the tribe of Levi [was] for Israel. [This priesthood is] now in abeyance because Israel did not fulfill the condition in Exodus 19:5.² But in the future it will be realized (Isaiah 61:6;³ Isaiah 66:21⁴).

“The first resurrection” is far from being the “first” of **ALL** resurrections, for a series of other prophetic (see **RESURRECTION**, page 8649)

2. “Now therefore, **IF** you will obey My voice indeed, and keep My covenant, **THEN** you shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people: for all the Earth is Mine: **and you shall be unto Me a Kingdom of PRIESTS** ...”
3. “But you shall be named the **PRIESTS** of the LORD: men shall call you the Ministers of our God: you shall eat the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast yourselves.”

Juanita S. Carey

(1930-2023)

Author of *E.W. Bullinger: A Biography*

We have learned of the death of one of our authors, Juanita S. Carey. Born in Lima, Peru in 1930, Juanita spent her teen years in Englewood, NJ, where she attended The Dwight School before moving on to Rosemont College. She married Dr. Mitchell Carey in 1955; the couple had five children and lived in Larchmont, NY.



After earning an MLS (Master of Library Science) at Queens College (CUNY), Juanita embarked on a decades-long career as a school librarian and teacher. An avid writer, she spent years researching and then writing the invaluable biography of biblical scholar Dr. E.W. Bullinger.¹ For over 20 years, she volunteered at Main Street Mission in Manchester, NH, and as an English tutor for Manchester's English as a Second Language program.

It was in the Autumn of 1983 that Juanita traveled to Great Britain to find out more about the life of E.W. Bullinger. She had become acquainted with his work years earlier when she began to study the Bible. Dr. Bullinger's *Critical Lexicon and Concordance to the English and Greek New Testament*² was among the first volumes she acquired for her Bible study library. Later, she read and enjoyed many of his other works: *How to Enjoy the Bible*,³ *Number in Scripture*,⁴ and *The Witness of the Stars*,⁵ to name a few. The minute detail with which Dr. Bullinger handled God's Word, and his reverence and love for it, greatly impressed her. Curious to learn more about the man, she looked for his biography. To her surprise, she dis-

covered that none had ever been written. The challenge proved irresistible. She decided to go to Great Britain and see what she could find for herself.

During her three-year stay in Great Britain, she was aided by many individuals. Notable among them was Mrs. Dorothy Bullinger Fielder, Dr. Bullinger's granddaughter. Mrs. Fielder graciously opened her home and her family papers to Juanita, and she spent many pleasant hours listening to her reminisce about her grandfather and Elizabeth Dodson. Mrs. Winifred Carpenter also gave her information and papers pertaining to her father, Mr. Charles Welch.⁶

Her biography on Bullinger was first published in Great Britain in 1988. The first edition of her book elicited many letters from admirers of Bullinger's work all over the world. Several of these responses added to her store of knowledge of Dr. Bullinger's life and work; one even gave valuable new information about the completion of *The Companion Bible*.⁷

In September 1997, she returned to Europe to continue her research for an enhanced second edition of her book. The new addition was originally published by Kregel Publications in 2000, and then finally by Bible Student's Press, 2012.

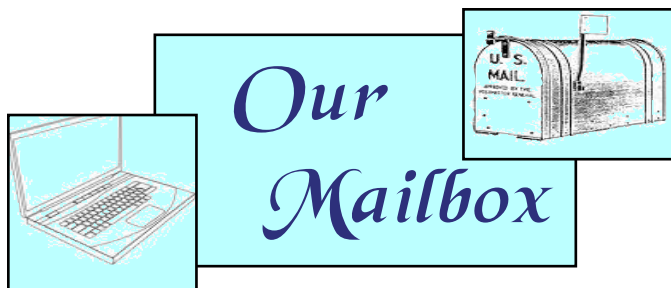

resurrections – hundreds of years before – will span the course of the Pre-Millennial “Day of Christ.”⁵ These earlier resurrections will all be in their own “order” or “class”: Elijah, David, the Twelve Apostles, etc.

Yet even all of these resurrections are *preceded* by one of superior revelation; for Paul reveals “the Administration of the Secret which has been concealed from the eons in God” (Ephesians 3:9, CV), where “your life is hid together with Christ in God,” so that,

Whenever Christ, our Life, should be manifested, then you also shall be manifested together with Him in Glory (Colossians 3:4, CV).

This glorious resurrection makes us “pre-expectant in the Christ” (Ephesians 1:12, CV). This is the earliest of all resurrections⁶ – the *Out-Resurrection* – which

However, throughout the age there have been many resurrections that were resuscitations, where the individual was restored to mortal life, just to die again: the young boy raised by Elijah (I Kings 17); the son of the Shunammite woman raised by Elisha (II Kings 4); those resurrected by Christ: Jairus' daughter (Mark 5), the widow's son (Luke 7), and Lazarus of Bethany (John 11); the saints raised at the time of Christ's death (Matthew 27); Tabitha/Dorcas

hates us, despises us, and wants nothing to do with us, because He is so holy and righteous.

As noted in prior lessons, God's essence is that of love. I John 4:9, 16 tells us plainly that “God *is* love.” It doesn't say that He *has* love, which He does, or that

Paul introduced in Philippians (the vital gateway⁷ epistle to the Secret Administration).

... the^{out} resurrection that is out from among the dead (Philippians 3:11, CV).

This all means that our Secret Expectation predates all prophetic hopes. Our expectation comes *hundreds of years before* the Great Tribulation and the Antichrist, and thus *precedes* the so-called “Rapture” (or “Snatching Away”) of I Thessalonians 4, as well as all of the resurrections associated with Israel's Pre-Millennial Kingdom. As glorious as “the Hope of Israel” will be, don't sell yourself short of our advanced exception (i.e., our “pre-expectant” appearance in the celestials with Christ)! **BSN**

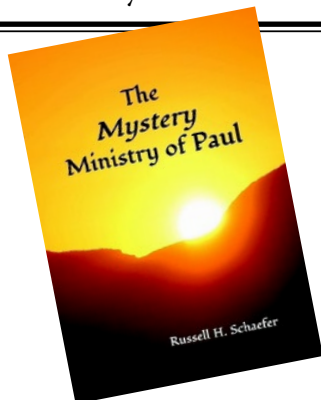

raised by Peter (Acts 9); Eutychus raised by Paul (Acts 20).

Therefore, every attribute of God is an expression of His essence. All of His attributes are used in the out-working of His love, of Who He is.

God created all, and the intent of this creation was to have an outlet for His love. God's love is a passionate, all-encompassing love that always has as its objective the benefit of the one receiving that love, whether the person receiving that love presently believes it, or is currently unaware of it.

Yet God is commending this love of His to us, seeing that, while we are still sinners, Christ died for our sakes (Romans 5:8, CV).

Thus, God's attributes are used as a means to lavish His love upon mankind. God has His plan of love, and He is executing it precisely. In executing this plan, God has to manifest all of His attributes so that mankind will reap the greatest benefit.

Yet God, being rich in mercy, because of His vast love with which He loves us (Ephesians 2:4, CV).

One might then naturally ask, "What are these attributes that He manifests"? The lessons to follow will deal with His Omniscience, Omnipotence, Omnipresence, His justice, longsuffering, patience, mercy, grace, orderliness and immanence. Each lesson will focus on one of those attributes.

In order to manifest His great love, God is working His plan (Logos), and every human being ever born,

or will be born, is part of His plan. **Nothing will be left to chance and not one person will be "lost," for the sovereign God is One,**

Who wills that all mankind be saved and come into a realization of the truth (I Timothy 2:4, CV). **BSN**

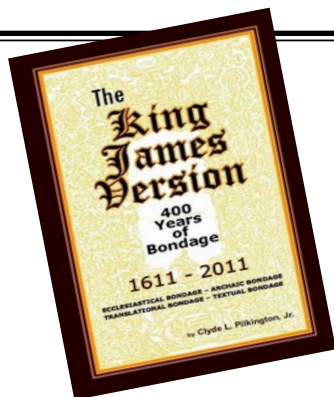
