**T**he world tells us that success is something that *we achieve* – a goal we reach, a legacy we build, a purpose we fulfill. Even in Christian circles, success is often tied to *what we do for God* – winning souls, growing ministries, making an impact.

Yet here's the truth: *Success is not something we create. It's something that God determines.* And, since *He alone is sovereign*, the only success that matters is the fulfillment of *His plans – not ours.*

### **GOD'S PLANS STAND – OURS DO NOT**

We like to think that we have control. We make plans, set goals, map out the future; but the reality is,

**God alone writes the story.**

*The Lord foils the plans of the nations; He thwarts the purposes of the peoples. But the plans of the Lord stand firm forever, the purposes of His heart through all generations (Psalm 33:10-11).*

It doesn't matter how much effort we put in, how strategic we are, or how much we want something –

*if it's not part of God's plans, it will not happen.*

At the same time, *nothing can stop His plans from unfolding exactly as He intended.*

- Joseph's brothers sold him into slavery, but God positioned him to save nations.
- Pharaoh hardened his heart, but God used him to display His power.
- Judas betrayed Jesus, but God had already planned redemption through the cross.

Every detail – *good, bad, or devastating* – serves His purpose, not ours.

our choices, actions and faithfulness – as if we have the power to alter the course of God's sovereign plans – but **we don't**.

*I am God, and there is none like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things that are not yet done, saying, “My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure” (Isaiah 46:9-10).*

**God isn't waiting for us to get it right so that His plans can move forward. His will is unfolding perfectly – through us, despite us, beyond us.**

That means:

- ✓ Your failures do *not* derail His plans.
- ✓ Your successes do *not* guarantee anything outside of His will.
- ✓ Your obedience is *not* what makes His plans work – it's what aligns you with the peace of trusting it.

We don't build success. **God defines it, controls it and fulfills it.**

### WHAT IF YOUR “FAILURE” IS GOD’S SUCCESS?

Humanly speaking, success is about **results** – what we accomplish, how much impact we have, what we leave behind – but what if God's definition looks nothing like ours?

- Noah spent 100 years building an ark while people mocked him. *Was that failure?*

- Jeremiah preached for decades, and no one listened. *Was that failure?*
- John the Baptist was imprisoned and executed. *Was that failure?*
- Jesus was rejected, crucified and abandoned by His closest followers. *Was that failure?*

No. Because **God's success is measured by His plans being fulfilled, not by human expectations.**


What looks like failure to us may be the *exact success that God ordained.*

### LIVING IN THE REALITY OF GOD’S SOVEREIGNTY

If success is *only* about the fulfillment of God's plans, then there is no pressure to “get it right.”

*You are not in charge.*

1. **Let go of the illusion of control.** You don't make or break God's plans. You don't carry the weight of success – *He does.*
2. **Stop measuring life by human standards.** The world defines success by influence, growth and achievement. God defines it by *His will being done.*
3. **Trust that what happens is exactly what was MEANT to happen.** There are no accidents, no detours, no “Plan B” with God. *Everything unfolds as He intended.*
4. **Rest in the freedom of His sovereignty.** If He ([see SUCCESS, last page](#))



I was talking with Chris Carnahan about God's sovereignty the other day, and we hit on something – how we *think* we're in control of our lives, but the truth is, what we want and what actually happens aren't even connected. We make plans, we push, we strive ... and then life just does its own thing.

Ever seen a kid in one of those toy cars at an amusement park? He's gripping the wheel, spinning it left and right, convinced he's the one steering. He thinks he's in control, but the car is locked onto a track. No matter what he does with that wheel, the ride is going exactly where it was designed to go.

That's us.

We live with the illusion that we're in control. We make plans, chase dreams, fight to stay on top, and act like we're the ones charting our own course. But the reality? That steering wheel in our hands isn't connected to anything. The track beneath us – God's sovereign will – is the only thing determining where we're actually going.

## THE GOD WHO ACTUALLY STEERS

Scripture makes it clear: we aren't the ones running the show.

- **Proverbs 16:9** – “*The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps.*” You can turn your little wheel all you want, but God is the one laying down the track.
- **Joseph's Story (Genesis 50:20)** – His brothers thought that they were ruining his life when they sold him into slavery. Turns out, they were just pawns in God's bigger plan to save an entire nation.
- **The Crucifixion of Jesus (Acts 2:23)** – The people who sentenced Jesus to death thought that they were making their own choice, but that moment had been written into history before the disruption of the world.

to accomplish His perfect plan, do we really think our little course corrections are going to make or break His design?

## WHY WE FIGHT IT

We resist this truth because it wrecks our ego. We like the idea that we're in charge. That our grit, smarts and hustle are what shape our destiny. That if we just work harder, think smarter and plan better, we can control the outcome.

But deep down, we know better.

Ever had life knock you flat? Ever made what seemed like the “right” decision, only for everything to go sideways? Ever looked back and realized that the thing you fought so hard to achieve was actually leading you somewhere that you never expected?

That's because you weren't steering. You never were. You were just spinning the wheel on a ride that was already set in motion.

## SO WHAT DO WE DO?

If God is sovereign, does that mean we just sit back, do nothing and let life happen? Nope. We still make choices. We still take action. But we do it with the understanding that the results are up to Him.

Here's how that changes everything:

- **Stop Stressing Over Outcomes** – If God is in control, you don't have to live in fear of messing up everything. Do your best, make wise choices,

but know that no mistake of yours can derail His plan.

- **Let Go of the Illusion** – Stop gripping the wheel like your life depends on it. You're not steering this thing. The sooner you accept that, the freer you'll be.
- **Trust the Track** – Even when life doesn't make sense, even when it feels like you're heading in the wrong direction, trust that God knows exactly where He's taking you.
- **Get Over Yourself** – If the universe isn't actually dependent on your ability to “figure it all out,” you can stop acting like it is. Relax. He's got it.

## THE BOTTOM LINE

We love the illusion of control. It makes us feel safe. But real safety isn't found in gripping a disconnected steering wheel – it's found in trusting the One who built the track.

God is sovereign. That means your life isn't random. Your struggles aren't meaningless. Your future isn't uncertain to Him. So stop white-knuckling that plastic wheel and let Him take you where He's already planned.

Because no matter how hard you spin that thing, you're not the one doing the driving. **BSN**



controls all things, then there is *no pressure, no striving, no fear of failure* – just **TRUST**.

#### **THE ONLY SUCCESS THAT MATTERS**

At the end of it all, **only one thing matters**: Did God’s plans come to pass? And since He is *absolutely sovereign*, the answer is *always, “YES.”*


